| No | Activity   | Actions   | Mitigation  | Low/Med/High |

| 1  | Cuts and grazes<br>Stings or bites from<br>vegetation or insects | No unprotected feet – wear suitable shoes,<br>boots or trainers – No open toes style.<br>Wear suitable clothing<br>(gloves at all times, sleeves and trousers)<br>All volunteers to use litter-pickers to collect<br>rubbish - NEVER scoop up items by hand<br>Be wary of uneven ground and trip hazards<br>including trailing vegetation | Undertake an on-site review of the area to be cleaned,<br>identify any hazards before beginning work. | Low/Med      |
| 2  | Slips, trips and falls   | Wear supportive and slip-resistant footwear<br>– No open toes style.<br>Take care when negotiating property steps<br>Observe ground and aware of potential trip<br>hazards<br>If in doubt don't carry on if an area looks<br>slippery or dangerous  | Take care when pavements are slippery from rain, leaves, ice, snow, etc.                              | Low/Med      |



| 3 | Syringes and medical waste | Site survey prior to event to check for any evidence of syringes.   | Volunteers finding syringes should not touch them, but<br>immediately notify the Parish Clerk who will arrange<br>disposal via the local authority.<br>All work must then cease in this particular area where the<br>items are found.<br>Any accidental piercing by syringe should be immediately<br>treated at medical practice or A & E. | Low/Med |

| 4 | Manual handling            | Volunteers with pre-existing injuries are not<br>to lift bags or heavy items<br>No more than one bag at a time to be<br>carried.  | Volunteers advised to be aware of their own limitations<br>and not lift heavy items found during the clean up.   | Low/Med |
| 5 | Dog Fouling                | Advise on issue of dog fouling during the<br>briefing<br>Do not touch dog fouling<br>If a volunteer steps in dog faeces, clean<br>shoes if possible<br>If found warn others in the vicinity | Advise the Parish Clerk to arrange local authority clean up.   | Low     |
| 6 | Hazardous chemicals        | Any suspicious drums, materials or<br>containers with contents not identifiable to<br>be left untouched   | Site survey at beginning of clean up<br>Advise the Parish Clerk to arrange local authority clean<br>up.  | Low     |
| 7 | Safeguarding children      | All staff on site to maintain vigilance where<br>members of the public not participating in<br>the litter picking are using the same pubic<br>space.  | All event volunteers to wear L.G.P.C. tabards to allow<br>easy identification.<br>In the event of an incident, immediately inform the local<br>Safeguarding Officer or Police and any other relevant<br>agencies   | Med     |



| 8 | Extreme cold or wet | Wear suitable warm layers and waterproof | Consider suspending work if weather is sufficiently | Low |
